**ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS TO IMPORT FROZEN HALAL
BONELESS BUFFALO MEAT FROM INDIA**

1. All meat parts have to be produce of the inspected Frigorifico Allana Limited (FAL) Abattoir at Paithan Road, Gevrai Village, Aurangabad, India. No frozen buffalo meat from any other uninspected abattoir establishments will be allowed.
2. The consignment shall be accompanied by health certificate issued by the Veterinary Authority of India certifying that:-
 - a. The meat is derived from animals that are healthy and free from Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD), Rinderpest, Anthrax, Beta-agonists, Nitrofurans and its metabolites, Chloramphenicol, Colisin and etc The meat is derived from animals that are healthy and free from Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD), Rinderpest, Anthrax, Beta-agonists, Nitrofurans and its metabolites, Chloramphenicol, Colisin and etc for the past 6 months
 - b. The meat comes from animals which:
 - (i) have remained, for at least three months prior to *slaughter*, in a *zone* of the *exporting country* where cattle and water buffaloes are regularly vaccinated against FMD and where an *official control programme* is in operation;
 - (ii) have been vaccinated at least twice with the last *vaccination* not more than six months, unless protective immunity has been demonstrated for more than six months, and not less than one month prior to *slaughter*;
 - (iii) were kept for the past 30 days in an *establishment*, and that FMD has not occurred within a 10 kilometre radius of the *establishment* during that period, or the *establishment* is a *quarantine station*;
 - (iv) have been transported, in a *vehicle* which was cleansed and disinfected before the cattle and water buffaloes were loaded, directly from the *establishment* of origin or *quarantine station* to the approved *slaughterhouse/abattoir* without coming into contact with other animals which do not fulfil the required conditions for export;
 - (v) have been slaughtered in an approved *slaughterhouse/abattoir*:
 - i. which is officially designated for export;
 - ii. in which no FMD has been detected during the period between the last *disinfection* carried out before *slaughter* and the shipment for export has been dispatched;
 - (vi) have been subjected to ante- and post-mortem inspections within 24 hours before and after *slaughter* with no evidence of FMD;

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- c. The meat comes from deboned carcasses:
 - a. from which the major lymphatic nodes have been removed;
 - b. which, prior to deboning, have been submitted to maturation at a temperature greater than + 2°C for a minimum period of 24 hours following *slaughter* and in which the pH value was less than 6.0 when tested in the middle of both the longissimus dorsi muscle.
 - d. Ante mortem and post-mortem examinations found animals to be free from infectious disease, and that the meat is fit for human consumption
3. The consignment shall be accompanied by Halal certificate.
 4. All official documents required under this importation must be surrendered to the Quarantine officer of this department at port of entry in Sabah.
 5. Any consignment arranged through an agent from Peninsular Malaysia will not be accepted
 6. Under Custom Act 1967 Custom (Prohibition of Imports) Amendment (No.7) Order 2004, all imported meat and chicken must be accompanied by Health Certificate issued by competent Health Authority of the exporting country stating the absence of the following prohibited drugs and drug residue:
 - a. Beta-agonists
 - b. Nitrofurans and its metabolites
 - c. Chloramphenicol
 - d. Colistin and etc
