

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS TO IMPORT PET FOOD FROM COUNTRY OF ORIGIN INTO SABAH

1. Each consignment of pet food shall be accompanied by a valid import permit issued by the Department of Veterinary Services (DVS) Sabah permitting the importation into Sabah.
2. Veterinary Health Certificate

Veterinary Health Certificate written in English dated within 14 days of export and signed and endorsed by the competent veterinary authority of **country of origin** attesting that :

- a. The pet food contains animal protein derived from fish, poultry, cattle, goats, sheep, deer, swine and buffalo which healthy and not from diseased animal, or which died from contamination or outbreak; *and*
- b. Pet food referred in the certificate has been manufactured according to standard processing technique and has been subjected to heat treatment to reach an internal core temperature of at least 70 degrees centigrade for a period of not less than 30 minutes or to any equivalent treatment which has been demonstrated to killed virus and bacteria; *and*
- c. The pet food has been manufactured entirely in the exporting country, in a manufacturing facility approved and monitored by the Competent Veterinary Authority of the exporting country; *and*
- d. Necessary precaution has been taken to prevent contamination of the pet food referred in the certificate from pathogen and other harmful material.

3. Certification

A certificate issued by a certified authority indicating pet food manufacturing processes that meet GMP or HACCP or equivalent.

4. Labelling and packaging requirement

- a. The list of raw material or ingredient and the nutritional data should be clearly stated on the packing or bag and labelled as pet food.
- b. Where the feed contains pork or its derivative or lard, the pet food shall be clearly labelled as "CONTAINS [state whether pork, or its derivative, or lard as the case may be]"
- c. The product package must be also clearly labelled with;
 - i. name and address of the manufacturer
 - ii. date of manufacture and expiry date
 - iii. batch / lot number
 - iv. directions for use for the intended animal species
 - v. list of ingredients
 - vi. nutritional data
- d. The products were packed and sealed directly into sterilized air tight packing/bags at the manufacturing plant.

5. Each consignment of pet food imported into Sabah shall be carried by ship or aircraft or any vehicle direct to the prescribed landing place or any other port in Sabah.
6. The Director of DVS Sabah may at any time when deem necessary to suspend importations either temporarily or permanently in the event of disease outbreaks or suspected disease outbreaks or in case of importation in contravention of the above regulations.
7. The Director of DVS Sabah reserves the right to amend the above regulations at any time as he may deem necessary.
