

**ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS TO IMPORT ANIMAL FEED (INCLUDING FEED ADDITIVES SUCH AS VITAMINS, MINERALS), IN-FEED ANTIBIOTICS INTO SABAH**

1. Each consignment of Animal Feed (including feed additives such as vitamins, minerals), In-feed antibiotics shall be accompanied by a valid import permit issued by the Department of Veterinary Services (DVS) Sabah permitting the importation into Sabah;

**AND**

2. (i) **Veterinary Health Certificate for import from overseas;**

Each consignment of Animal Feed (including feed additives such as vitamins, minerals), In-feed antibiotics shall be accompanied by a Veterinary Health Certificate **written in English** dated within 14 days of export and signed and endorsed by the competent veterinary authority of **country of origin** giving details of the consignment (such as name and address of consignor, consignee and manufacturing facility and quantity, type and origin of raw material and products) and certifying that:

- a) the animal feed (including feed additives such as vitamins, minerals), In-feed antibiotics has been manufactured entirely in the exporting country and in a manufacturing facility approved and monitored by the Competent Veterinary Authority of the exporting country/state.
- b) the animal feed (including feed additives such as vitamins, minerals), In-feed antibiotics shall be free from pathogenic bacteria such as *Salmonella*, pathogenic *Vibrio*, all banned antibiotics [***Avoparcin, Chloramphenicol, Colistin (Polymixin E), Erythromycin, Enrofloxacin, Tetracycline, Ceftiofur, Tylosin, Fosfomycin Nitrofurans, Teicoplanin, Vancomycin, Carbadox and Olaquinox***], chemicals and pharmacologically active substances
- c) the animal feed (including feed additives such as vitamins, minerals), In-feed antibiotics shall be free from mammalian meal and bone meal and that the Residual Ammonia content shall be less than 0.5%.
- d) there has been no outbreak of African Swine Fever (ASF), Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) and Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) within 10 km radius of the manufacturing facility.

- e) pelletized / crumbled animal feed (including feed additives such as vitamins, minerals), in-feed antibiotics referred in the certificate has been manufactured according to standard processing technique and has been subjected to heat treatment to reach an internal core temperature of at least seventy degrees centigrade (70°C) for a period of not less than thirty (30) minutes or to any equivalent treatment which has been demonstrated to kill virus and bacteria.
- f) Shall be steam or flame dried.
- g) All necessary precaution has been taken to prevent contamination of the animal feed referred in the certificate from pathogens.
- h) Maximum moisture level shall be 10%.
- i) Hormones (***Diethylstilbestrol, Dienestrol, Hexestrol and Antithyroid Agent***) shall be absent and aflatoxins shall be less than 10 ppb.
- j) Composition of the ingredients and chemicals shall be indicated on the label.

OR

(ii) **Veterinary Health Certificate for import from Peninsular Malaysia**

- a) The animal feed (including feed additives such as vitamins, minerals), In-feed antibiotics manufactured in Peninsular Malaysia must comply to Feed (Manufacture and Sale of Feed or Feed Additive) Regulations 2012.
- b) Attach a certified true copy of :-
  - i. **Certificate of Registration of Manufacturer of Feed or Feed Additive [SAMH 53(2)(g)01]** with the product name(s) must be listed and produced in plant registered,
  - ii. **Certificate of Registration of Seller of Feed or Feed Additive [SAMH 53(2)(g)02]** with the product name(s) must be listed, and
  - iii. Veterinary Health Certificate from Department of Veterinary Service Malaysia certifying that there has been no outbreak of African Swine Fever, Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) and Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) within 10 km radius of the manufacturing facility.
  - iv. The animal feed (including feed additives such as vitamins, minerals), In-feed antibiotics, imported from oversea and re-export from Peninsular Malaysia must comply to Feed (Licence to Import Feed or Feed Additive) Regulations 2012.

- a. Attach a certified true copy of **Licence to Import Feed or Feed Additives) (SAMH 53(2)(b)(c)01)** with the product name(s) must be listed in the licence.
3. For in-feed antibiotic.  
Attach a certified true copy of product Registration Certificate with the National Pharmaceutical Regulatory Agency (NPRA) of the said product with the product name(s) must be listed in the certificate.
4. Labelling
  - a. The list of raw materials or ingredients and the nutritional data should be clearly stated on the packing or bag and labelled as animal, shrimp and fish feed.
  - b. Where the feed contains pork or its product, the animal feed (including feed additives such as vitamins, minerals), In-feed antibiotics shall be clearly labelled as contain pork or its product.
  - c. The product package must be also clearly labelled with;
    - i. name and address of the manufacturer
    - ii. date of manufacture and expiry date
    - iii. batch/lot number
    - iv. directions for use for the intended animal species
    - v. list of ingredients
    - vi. nutritional data
5. The Director of Sabah Veterinary Services may at any time when deemed necessary suspend the importation of the products either temporarily or permanently in the event of disease outbreaks or suspected disease outbreaks or in case of importation in contravention of the above conditions.
6. The Director of Sabah Veterinary Services reserves the right to amend the above conditions at any time as he may deem necessary.
