

**ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS TO IMPORT TABLE EGGS FROM AVIAN INFLUENZA  
FREE STATES IN PENINSULAR MALAYSIA**

1. Veterinary Certificate from Veterinary Authority of **state origin** attesting that:
  - a. **\*District origin** is free of Avian Influenza (*Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza-HPAI and Low Pathogenic Avian Influenza-LPAI*)
  - b. There has been no positive case(s) of Avian Influenza (HPAI and LPAI) within ten (10) kilometre radius from ***\*the farm***.
  - c. **\*The farm** is under intensified government surveillance program on Avian Influenza and has been tested and found to be free from Avian Influenza.
  - d. The eggs originated from farm(s) which have been accredited under **MyGAP** and is under regular health inspection by veterinarian with relevant avian experience.
  - e. The eggs were derived from layers which had been kept in an Avian Influenza free farm for 21 days prior to and at time of the collection of the eggs; **never** been vaccinated against Avian Influenza and Salmonellosis and were tested negative for both diseases three (3) months prior to shipment.
  - f. The eggs originated from establishment that have no outbreak or disease of Newcastle Disease, Fowl Cholera, Avian Chlamydiosis, Avian Infectious Bronchitis, Avian Infectious Laryngotracheitis, Avian Mycoplasmosis (*Mycoplasma gallisepticum* and *Mycoplasma synoviae*), Duck Virus Hepatitis, Fowl Typhoid, Infectious Bursal Disease (Gumboro disease), Turkey Rhinotracheitis for the past six (6) months prior to export.
  - g. Are transported in new packing material
  
2. On Arrival
  - a. A minimum of five (5) eggs shall be taken randomly at the point of arrival for disease screening.
  - b. If the eggs which have been or is about to be imported is in the opinion of the State Veterinary Authority (SVA), infected with any disease in condition 1 or likely to have been in-contact with any infected or diseased animal or animal products, the SVA

may at this discretion cause such eggs and any contact thereof to be destroyed at once at the expense of the importer.

3. The Director of Sabah Veterinary Services may at any time when deemed necessary suspend the importation of the products either temporarily or permanently in the event of disease outbreaks or suspected disease outbreaks or in case of importation in contravention of the above conditions.
4. The Director of Sabah Veterinary Services reserves the right to amend the above conditions at any time as he may deem necessary.
5. The confirmed time of arrival should be made known to the Animal Quarantine Office at **Kota Kinabalu International Airport Terminal 1 (KKIA T1), Tel: 088-413401 or 088-413400 (Fax)**, at least 2 days in advance.
